

## LEGAL NOTICE

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84-907, notice is hereby given that the Tax Equalization and Review Commission will meet on Thursday, January 21, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., to consider revisions to the Rules and Regulations of the Tax Equalization and Review Commission (Title 442, Nebraska Administrative Code), Chapter 5. The purposes of the proposed changes to the Rules and Regulations are (1) to update procedures for receiving appeals and conducting hearings, and (2) to simplify language and correct formatting and grammatical errors.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the meeting will be conducted only by videoconference or by other electronic communication as permitted by Executive Order No. 20-36. The opportunity to be heard will be afforded to any interested person, in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Commission, upon written request to Robert W. Hotz, Chairman, Nebraska Tax Equalization and Review Commission, PO Box 95108, Lincoln, NE 98509. Such written requests must be received at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled hearing. Unscheduled testimony may be heard following scheduled testimony. Written comments may be mailed to the above address or FAXed to 402-471-7720, and must be filed with the Commission at least 24 hours prior to the hearing in order to be made a part of the record.
