It appears that the ninth sale that is in the Sandhills analysis that is not in the R&O statistics, is a sale that became over 5% improved during the rural review that was conducted for 2017. With the larger sample size, a removal of a sale has little effect on the analysis, which still indicates that sales after the study period are consistently lower than the previous eighteen months.

There should only be 8 sales in the study period.
